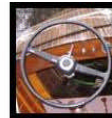

Muskoka Launch Livery Rental Agreement

- ? Livery agrees to provide 18' Duke Playmate 48-06 or 51-07, 25hp, open wooden launch, fitted with safety equipment for four persons, navigation chart and fuel, in good working order, delivered to client's designated location and picked up at rental period completion, as agreed.
- ? Client agrees to pay rental fee of \$1,200/week, unless otherwise agreed, as well as a \$2,000 deposit, by cash or cheque as agreed.
- ? Client is responsible for any damage incurred to vessel during the rental period, either through use or while moored.
- ? Livery will deduct rental fee and return balance to client after pick-up and inspection.
- ? Livery does not consider seasonal fading of the varnish, minor blemishes in finish caused by dock rubs and normal use to be damage.
- ? Client presents him/herself as boat worthy and proficient in navigation for the waters being travelled.
- ? Client provides a deposit in advance to secure the boat rental unless waived by the livery.
